

Our first destination was the Nehru Zoological Park. Then, we moved to our next destination Golconda Fort, a fortified citadel built by the Qutub Shahi dynasty as the capital of the Golconda Sultanate. Golconda flourished as a trade centre of large diamonds, known as the Golconda Diamonds. The view of the Hyderabad city from the fort was captivating. Later, we went to Lumbini Park and Hussain Sagar Lake. As we cruised on the Hussain Sagar Lake we saw the large monolithic statue of the Gautama Buddha that stands on Gibraltar Rock in the middle of the lake.







Ramoji Film City is an integrated film studio complex located in Hyderabad, spread over 1,666 acres, it is the largest integrated film city in the world and as such has been certified by the Guinness World Records as the largest studio complex in the world. We were mesmerised and awestruck by the huge movie sets of Bahubali and Chandramukhi.

We explored the Salar Jung Museum renowned for being the largest one-man collection of antiques in the world. It has earned the distinction of being the third largest museum in India and is a must-visit for art and history enthusiasts.

The Charminar is a historical monument with four ornate minarets attached and supported by four grand arches of the monument. It is known globally as a symbol of Hyderabad and listed among the most recognized structures in India. Later, we visited Birla Mandir and the NTR Samadhi, a memorial park.

Our school trip exposed us to different cultures, traditions, food, languages and ways to see the world; encouraging understanding, appreciation for diversity. It had a positive impact on personal development, building confidence as students were taken out of their home environment and comfort zone. Many students experienced their first taste of relative freedom.
